

# 2010 Miss Arkansas Beef Contest

## **RULES & REGULATIONS:**

1. The young woman chosen as Miss Arkansas Beef will represent the beef industry during the coming year. Duties may include, but are not limited to, attendance at Summer Conference, Annual Convention, fairs, beef cattle sales, shows, ACWA Beef Ambassador Contest, ACWA Beef Cookoff and other events as requested. Participants should possess a well rounded knowledge of the agriculture industry and the beef industry in particular.
2. Contestants must be recommended by an Arkansas Cattlemen's Association member or by a local Cattlemen's Association.
3. Each participant is responsible for their own entry fee and lodging. They may be sponsored by a local Cattlemen's Association or Breed Association. Each local cattlemen's association is encouraged to sponsor at least one participant.
4. A chaperone must accompany each participant. Chaperones should possess maturity, integrity and character to provide proper supervision for the contestant. Chaperones will be responsible for their own expenses or as determined by the sponsoring organization.
5. Contestants must be age 16, but not over 21 years of age by August 1, 2009. Contestants must be single and never have been married. Miss Arkansas Beef must remain single throughout her reign. Should Miss Arkansas Beef be unable or unwilling to fulfill her duties, the first runner up will assume the title.
6. A \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to the winner at the completion of her reign.
7. The Arkansas Cattlemen's Association will award Miss Arkansas Beef \$250 in cash. The first runner-up will receive \$100 in cash and the second runner-up will receive \$50 in cash in addition to other suitable awards.
