ACA Support Lincoln, Murkowski Efforts to Reverse EPA Finding

Little Rock (Jan.22, 2010) – The Arkansas Cattlemen's Association is strongly supporting a joint resolution by Senators Blanche Lincoln (D-AR), Lisa Murkowski (R-AK) and others, to reverse the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) recent finding that greenhouse gases (GHG) are an "endangerment to public health and welfare."

The ACA is pleased that Senator Lincoln and others have chosen to take a stand against the EPA. The Administration's decision to regulate greenhouse gas emissions without science justification will most definitely hinder the U.S.'s ability to remain competitive in a growing global marketplace. We believe it was never the intent of the Clean Air Act to regulate GHGs from sources that include farms, ranches, hospitals, office buildings and schools.

The ACA applauds Senator Lincoln and others for their leadership in challenging the EPA on this hindering regulation.
